Already making an impact

Much has already been accomplished in New Hampshire with more than 100 early movers and 300 native Granite-staters already here. Imagine what 1000 could do!

Already, early movers have run for office and won! Others have been appointed to offices on school, budget, and planning boards. The New Hampshire Liberty Alliance, founded by FSP participants, produces an annual report card on state legislators and closely screens all newly-proposed legislation. Free Staters also chair New Hampshire's Republican Liberty Caucus and Democratic Freedom Caucus.

About the Free State Project

The Free State Project is a plan for 20,000 liberty-oriented people to move to New Hampshire and work within its political system to reduce the size and scope of government. Free Staters will work to reduce burdensome taxation and regulation, reform state and local laws to expand individual rights and free markets, opt out of federal mandates, and press for the restoration of constitutional federalism.

The Free State Project is a strategy for liberty in our lifetime. It is not tied to any political party. It does not run candidates for election, or financially support or endorse them. It does not require dues. Members are free to choose wherever they want to live in New Hampshire.

Top reasons to move to New Hampshire now

- New Hampshire has no general income tax, no general sales tax, and no capital gains tax.
- The State Supreme Court has ruled private property cannot be taken for private economic development.
- The state has some of the most pro-Second Amendment laws in the nation.
- It is third in the nation for the highest percentage of high tech jobs. It is ranked second for new job growth for states with populations less than 1.5 million.
- It is ranked second in the nation as most tax-friendly to business. No inventory tax, no tax on machinery or equipment.
- Towns vote on their budgets line-by-line, which holds politicians accountable for their spending.
- Libertarians currently hold 30 public offices in the state.
- It is ranked the "Most Livable State in the Nation"! Whether your ideal home is oceanfront, lakefront, or mountaintop, a thriving metropolitan area, a quaint New England town, a large acreage homestead, or a cabin deep in the forest, you will find it here.
- You will help the nation and the world see libertarian ideals at work in government.
